## Supplies list, 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Shrine Catholic Academy

Students are required to have the following supplies for school:

1. **The pencil case:** pencils, pens (blue or black, red), set of markers, crayons or pencils, scissors, glue stick, ruler (with both inches and centimeters)
2. **For all classes:** To help students develop organization skills, all Academy students need to provide the following: wide-ruled looseleaf paper, 6 single color one-subject spiral notebooks and matching single color folder. Example: Purple-History; Yellow- Literature; Dark Blue- English; Green- Science; Red-Math; Light Blue- Religion. *Elective teachers will provide a supply list for their class separately.*
3. **For Math:** graph paper, protractor—simple and plain, compass (buy a good one)  
Calculator (Optional)—**under \$20**—one that computes fractions. Package of graph paper (1/4” size is best).
4. **For the good of all:** 1 or 2 boxes of Kleenex, 2 reams of printer/copy paper (to Homeroom teacher)
5. **Recommended:** paperback dictionary—(i.e. *Webster’s New World Dictionary*), 64MB USB Flash Drive (2.0) for all computer students or any student using Power Point for presentations of school projects
